

Driving Directions

These are directions for driving a car to the places that you'll need to get to if you're driving to the wedding.

The map below gives an overview of the whole area. Several key places are marked by green blobs.



Vasa is the nearest large town to where the wedding will take place and where you will most likely arrive by train, plane or car. Vöri (Fin: Vöri) is both the town where the wedding will be and the county in which it is. The church is just outside the centre of Vöri.

Reipelt (Fin: Reipelt) is where the reception will take place and is south of Vöri.

Replot is the island NW of Vasa on which the family party on the Friday will be. If you're coming to this, we'd rather you didn't drive there, since parking is very limited. Instead, we'll be laying on a bus. If you've not had details of this, get in touch with us.

I'll give place names in Swedish and Finnish where they're likely to appear in both languages on signposts, so there's no confusion.

Central Vasa to Vörå Church

The most difficult part of getting to Vörå is getting out of town the right way - then it's pretty simple.

The important road to find in the centre is

Vasaesplanaden (Fin: Vaasanpuistikko), which is a big road that goes through town and along one side of the town square (the only drivable road going past the square).

Take this NE (passing the square on your left) and follow it out of town. It goes over a bridge that crosses the railway line. You stick on this same road for about 20 minutes, following signs to Kokkola, road E8.

Turn right when you reach a junction signposted to Vörå (Fin: Vöyri). It's the first big right turn with a sliproad. Then follow this for about another 20 minutes.

Look out for a blue/green petrol station on your left. After this you come over the brow of a hill, with a reduced speed limit, and come to a crossroads with a sign pointing right to Isokyro and a supermarket (S-Market) on the left. This is Vörå and you want to turn left at this crossroads to go into the centre of town. You should pass a shop on your left called Halpa Halli almost immediately.

You now need to drive all the way through the town and continue on the same road out the other side. A short way out the other side (3km away from the big junction), take a small road left to the church. You can see the church from the junction and it's clearly signposted as well (Vörå Kyrka).

Getting from the church to the house, it should be possible to follow others, but these directions may come in handy if you find yourself on your own.

Return to the road on which you came through Vörå and go all the way back through Vörå to the junction with the big road (by the S-Market). Go straight over the big road, taking the road signposted to Isokyro (the one I mentioned at the junction in the above instructions).

Follow this for about 10 minutes until you see a blue sign announcing that you're entering Rejpelt (Fin: Rekipelto). A short distance after this, turn off left onto a gravel road signposted to Lehmäjoki.

After 4km you'll come to the house: it's on the left; it's the only yellow house on the road; there'll be a Finnish flag flying; and there's a postbox on the right side of the road, opposite the driveway entrance.
